

A QUESTIONNAIRE – GREEN EDUCATION Back to the Nature

University Students' Thoughts about the use of living animals in education and their awareness of the laws for protecting nature and animals

This questionnaire is prepared to identify the attitudes of people towards nature. It also aims to search for increasing animals' prosperity. It does not have a goal to object to the beliefs of people or to criticize them.

The participants are 350 university students. Their ages are between 18-20. The questionnaire has 62 questions. Each question has five choices: strongly agree, agree, partly agree, disagree, strongly disagree.

As a result of the study, the majority of the university students think that people do not give enough importance to nature and animals. According to them, there should be classes at schools to teach the importance of nature and animals and the ways to protect them.
