In recent years, The Mosaic expanded its scope by opening a social entrepreneurship department with an international group of young graduates in economy and architecture. This is specializing in eco-architecture and focusing on projects with social purposes. The Mosaic's director is specialized in sustainable architecture and is certified KlimaHaus. Currently, The Mosaic is fundraising to design and build a sustainable residence (using only renewable energies) for retired artists, which will include rooms for music and visual arts seminars for old and young artists to work together, a gallery and a concert venue. One of its future projects is to build an eco-village.

The Mosaic develops its activities mainly by :

- Delivering seminars and in-service training both on art and environment subjects including the use of renewable energies
- Organizing and promoting cultural events
- Liaising with London councils for education services
- Designing and delivering innovative workshops for the UK school system
- Research into the arts and architecture
- Fundraising to develop social ventures in sustainable architecture, especially for disadvantaged groups
- Participating to European Union projects
- The Mosaic has been the coordinator of Grundtvig and Comenius projects and is currently leading the environmental education for children in the ARTinED project 518649-LLP-2011-IT-COMENIUS-Multilateral, an innovative didactic package to teach environmental education to children by using multi-art forms. The Mosaic also carried out research on education, in association with the Institute of Education, University of London.

The Mosaic has got experience in working within European cooperation by having developed successful partnerships within the LLP programme in decentralized and centralized actions.

In this LEONARDO partnership, this partner could develop a training about the link between buildings and renewable energy, by using a theoretical and practical approach and a focus on transferring the most advanced practices available in the UK. The Mosaic will also liaise with companies and vocational institutes in the UK to organize visits and interviews with the learners to further expand their experience on the subject.
